PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the center of tropical depression "Falcon" was estimated based on all available data at 1,015 km east of Virac, Catanduanes (13.6n, 133.6e) with maximum sustained winds of 45 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 60 km/h. it is moving north northwest at 20 km/h.
