PRESENT WEATHER:

At 10:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "OMPONG" was located based on all available data in the 30 Km West of Laoag City, Ilocos Norte (18.2°N, 120.3°E) with maximum sustained winds of 170 KM/H near the center and gustiness of up to 260 KM/H. It is moving West at 25 KM/H. Southwest monsoon enhanced by the typhoon will bring occasional light to moderate rains over Bicol Region
