**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At **3:00 AM today**, the center of Tropical Storm "Jolina" was estimated based on all available data at the vicinity of Santiago, Isabela (**16.8°N, 121.4°E**) with maximum sustained winds of **75 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **120 km/h**. It is forecast to move west northwest at **20 km/h**.
