PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm "Odette" was estimated based on all available data including Aparri Doppler Radar in the vicinity of Gattaran, Cagayan (18.1N, 121.9E) with maximum winds of 75 KM/H near the center and gustiness of up to 100 KM/H. It is forecast to move West at 24 KM/H.
