At 4:00PM Today, the center of Tropical Depression "GORIO" was estimated based on all available data at 565 km East of Legazpi City, Albay (13.5°N 128.9°E) with maximum sustained winds of 55 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 65 kph. It is forecasted to move North Northwest at 15 kph. Southwest Monsoon affecting the Western Section of Luzon and Visayas.
