### PRESENT WEATHER:

At **3:00 PM today**, the center of Tropical Storm "Jolina" was estimated based on all available data at 270 km West Northwest of Sinit, Ilocos Sur (**18.4°N, 118.0°E**) with maximum sustained winds of **80 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **95 km/h**. It is forecast to move northwest at **24 km/h**.

Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – **evacuation** rather than rescue.
