PRESENT WEATHER:

- As of 11:00 AM today, Lower Main Pampanga River at Arayat Station is now in slow recession reaching below alert level status. Slow recession of the lower main Pampanga River will continue further.
- Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers and thunderstorms will prevail over the basin area until the entire weekend.
- The public and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) within the basin are advised to take appropriate actions to mitigate the adverse impacts of riverine (fluvial) flooding along low-lying riverside areas.

AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL (MM) AS OF 11:00 AM TODAY:

Past 24-hr observed rainfall = 10 MM

Forecast 24-hr basin rainfall = Less than 5 MM
