

<b>WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b>Rivers and Tributaries in:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• SURIGAO DEL SUR particularly Cantillan, Torocan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.</li><li>• DINAGAT ISLANDS particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet .</li><li>• AGUSAN DEL SUR particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan.</li><li>• AGUSAN DEL NORTE particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran.</li><li>• SURIGAO DEL NORTE particularly Surigao and Magallanes</li></ul>
