PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "PAOLO" was located based on all available data at 870 km East of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan (17.9°N, 129.9°E) with maximum sustained winds of 130 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 160 km/h. It is forecast to move North at 15 km/h. Meanwhile, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 135 km West of Coron, Palawan (11.9°N, 119.0°E).


PUBLIC WARNING:
