AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE EYE OF TYPHOON "AMBO" (VONGFONG) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 250 KM EAST OF CATARMAN, NORTHERN SAMAR (12.1 °N, 126.9 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 150 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 180 KM/H. IT IS MOVING TOWARDS THE WEST AT 15 KM/H.
