**PRESENT WEATHER:**

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF SEVERE TROPICAL STORM "SARAH" {FUNG-WONG} WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 420 KM EAST NORTHEAST OF APARRI, CAGAYAN OR 340 KM EAST OF BASCO, BATANES (20.1 °N, 125.2 °E), WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 95 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 115 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTH NORTHWEST AT 25 KM/H. MEANWHILE, AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) (FORMERLY "RAMON") WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 55 KM WEST SOUTHWEST OF IBA, ZAMBALES (14.7 °N, 119.8 °E).

<b>WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Apayao – upper Abulug.</li><li>• Ifugao – all rivers and its tributaries.</li><li>• Mountain Province - all rivers and its tributaries.</li><li>• Abra – upper Abra, Tineg, and Ikmin.</li><li>• Kalinga – all rivers and its tributaries</li><li>• Benguet – upper Bauang</li></ul>

People living near the mountain slopes and low-lying areas near the above-mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are **still advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.**

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take precautions and appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
