WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Agusan Del Sur particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan.• Dinagat Islands particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet.• Surigao Del Sur particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.• Agusan Del Norte particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran.• Surigao Del Norte particularly Surigao and Magallanes.
