PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 165km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes (21.9N, 122.3E). Ridge of a High Pressure Area (HPA) extending across Luzon and Visayas. Easterlies affecting the eastern section of Mindanao.
