PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 135km West of Basco, Batanes (20.3N, 120.7E). Ridge of a High Pressure Area (HPA) extending across Luzon and Visayas. Easterlies affecting the eastern section of Mindanao.
