TRIBUTARIES OF UPPER AND MIDDLE MAIN AGNO RIVER:

- Ambayao River

- Streams

LOWER AGNO RIVER AND ITS TRIBUTARIES

- Tarlac, Camiling, Bayaoas Rivers and Streams

ALLIED RIVERS

- Pantal-Sinocalan River and Tributaries-Tuboy, Ingalera, Tagamusing Rivers and Streams

PUBLIC WARNING:

Generally, water levels of rivers within the Basin are still below alert stage. However, Monsoon Rains is expected to prevail over the Basin until this weekend. Thus, slow to gradual rise of water levels particularly the small tributaries/streams and the allied river systems within the basin are expected.

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are advised to take necessary precautionary measures.
