##### 2. LOWER AGNO RIVER AND ITS TRIBUTARIES

- Tarlac, Camiling Rivers and Tributary Streams

##### 3. ALLIED RIVERS

- SIOCALAN RIVER – Tuboy, Ingalera, Tagamusing Rivers and Tributary Systems
- CAYANGA RIVER – Bued – Patalan, Angalacan and Aloragat Rivers

#### ACTIONS TAKEN:

##### **NDRRMC-OPCEN**

- Disseminated **Flood Bulletin No. 1 for Agno and Allied River Basins** to OCD Regional Centers I and III through SMS and facsimile and uploaded same at the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Center to undertake precautionary measures in their Area of Responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
