#### **AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL AS OF 11:00 AM TODAY**

**PAST 24 -HOURS ENDING AT 10:00 AM = 12 MM**  
**FORECAST FOR THE NEXT 12-HOURS = LIGHT RAINS**

#### **WATERWAYS TO BE AFFECTED:**

1. Upper Main Cagayan River
2. Middle Main Cagayan River
3. Tributary Rivers (Pinacanauan of Ilagan San Pablo and Tuguegarao, Ganano, Magat, Chico, Pared and Dummun River)

Generally rivers within the basin are still relatively low. However, Northeasterly windflow (Northeast Monsoon) will bring light rains over the basin. People living near mountain slopes and adjacent to or along the above mention waterways and the Disaster Risk Reduction Management Councils (DRRMC) are advised to be prepared and to be alert for possible flash floods at midstream and downstream areas.
