EXPECTED HYDROLOGICAL RESPONSE:

1. Gradual rise of middle main Cagayan River and Magat River

- FLOODING IS THREATENING WITHIN THE NEXT 12 HOURS: in the low lying areas of Gamu, Ilagan, Tumauini, Delfin Albano, Sto Tomas, Cabagan, Sta Maria and San Pablo.
- Gradual rise of lower main Cagayan River and its tributaries Pinacanauan River of Tuguegarao, Pared River, Dummun River, Zinundungan River, and Chico River.
 - FLOODING IS THREATENING WITHIN THE NEXT 12 HOURS: in the low lying areas of Tuguegarao City, Enrile, Solana, Iguig, Amulung, Alcala, Gattaran, Lallo, Lasam, Baggao, Camalanuigan, and Aparri

Residents in the low lying areas and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

ACTIONS TAKEN:

NDRRMC-OPCEN

- Disseminated Flood Bulletin No. 01 for Cagayan river basins to OCD Regional Center II through SMS and facsimile and uploaded same at the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMC II through the OCD Regional Center to undertake precautionary measures in their Area of Responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low – lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
