AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL (mm):

PAST 24-HRS ENDING AT **8:00 AM** TODAY = **35 mm**

FORECAST FOR THE NEXT 12 HOURS = **MODERATE TO HEAVY RAINS**

EXPECTED HYDROLOGICAL RESPONSE:

- Slow rise of middle main Cagayan River and its tributaries Magat, Siffu, Mallig Rivers, Pinacanauan Rivers of Ilagan, Tumauni and San Pablo.
 - **Flooding is possible within the next 12 hours in the low lying areas of Naguilian, Gamu, Ilagan, Tumauni, Delfin Albano, Sto. Tomas, Cabagan, Sta. Maria, and San Pablo.**
- Slow rise of lower main Cagayan River and its tributaries Pinacanauan River of Tuguegarao, Pared, Dumon, Zinundungan, and Chico Rivers.
 - **Flooding is possible within the next 12 hours in the low lying areas of Tuguegarao City, Enrile, Solana, Iguig, Amulung, Alcala, Gattaran, Lallo, Lasam Baggao, Camalanuigan, and Aparri.**

PUBLIC WARNING:

People living in the low lying areas particularly the above mentioned areas and the Local DRRM Councils concerned are advised to be alert and take appropriate actions.

ACTIONS TAKEN:

NDRRMC-OPCEN

- Disseminated **Flood Bulletin No. 01 for Cagayan River Basin** to **OCD Regional Center II** through SMS and facsimile and uploaded same at the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Center to undertake precautionary measures in their area of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas if situation warrants.
