1. Slow rise of water level in Lake Buhi/Buhi Station

- URBAN FLOODING IS THREATENING: In the low-lying areas of Pob. Buhi

2. Slow rise of water level in Lake Bato/Bato Station

- URBAN FLOODING IS THREATENING: In the low-lying areas of Bato, Nabua, Libon, Polangui, Oas, Ligao

3. Slow rise of water level in Ombao, Bicol Region

- URBAN FLOODING IS THREATENING: In the low-lying areas of Ombao, Baa, Bula, Pili

4. Slow rise of water level in Camaligan, Bicol Region

- URBAN FLOODING IS THREATENING: In the low-lying areas of Camaligan, Bombon, Magarao, Canaman, Naga City, Gainza, Milaor, Minalabac, Pamplona, San Fernando

5. Slow rise of water level in Balongay, Bicol Region

- URBAN FLOODING IS THREATENING: In the low-lying areas of Calabanga

6. Slow rise of water level in Sipocot, Sipocot Region

- **URBAN FLOODING IS THREATENING**: In the low-lying areas of Cabusao, Libmanan, Sipocot
