### **EXPECTED HYDROLOGICAL RESPONSE:**

1. Continues Recession of Middle Main Cagayan River and Magat River.

Flooding is no longer threatening

In the low lying areas of Gamu, Ilagan, Tumuini, Delfin Albano, Sto Tomas, Cabagan, Sta. Maria, and San Pablo, this is final for the said areas.

2. Slow recession of lower main Cagayan River and its tributaries Pinacanauan River of Tuguegarao, Pared River, Dummun River, Zinundungan River, and Chico River.

Flooding is still threatening within the next 12 hours

In the low lying areas of Tuguegarao City, Enrile, Solana, Iguig, Amulung, Alcala, Gattaran, Lallo, Lasam Baggao, Camalanuigan, and Apparri.

THE RESIDENTS IN THE LOW LYING AREAS AND THE DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCILS CONCERNED ARE ADVISED TO TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTIONS.

#### **ACTION/S TAKEN:**

NDRRMC Flood Bulletin No. 02 for Cagayan River Basin system was disseminated to OCD/RDRRMC- II through facsimile, SMS and website for further dissemination to the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.

Directed RDRRMC II through the OCD Regional Center to undertake precautionary measures in their area of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
