- 1. Slow rise of UPPER MAIN CAGAYAN RIVER and its TRIBUTARIES:
GANANO, MAGAT and SIFFU RIVERS.**
 - **FLOODING IS THREATENING:** In the low-lying areas of Echague, Jones, Angadanan, Alicia and Cauayan
- 2. Slow rise of MIDDLE MAIN CAGAYAN RIVER and its TRIBUTARIES:
PINACANAUAN RIVERS OF ILAGAN, TUMAUNI and SAN PABLO.**
 - **FLOODING IS THREATENING:** In the low-lying areas of Naguiuan, Gamu, Ilagan, Tumauni, Delfin Albano, Sto Tomas, Cabagan, Sta Maria and San Pablo
- 3. Slow rise of LOWER MAIN CAGAYAN RIVER and its TRIBUTARIES:
PINACANAUAN RIVER OF TUGUEGARAO, CHICO, PARED and DUMMUN RIVERS.**
 - **FLOODING IS THREATENING:** In the low-lying areas of Tuguegarao City, Enrile, Tuao, Solana, Iguig, Amulung, Alcalá, Gattaran, Lallo, Lasam, Baggao, Camalanuigan and Aparri

PUBLIC WARNING:

- People living near low lying areas particularly those adjacent to and along the above mentioned rivers are alerted against possible landslides and flashfloods and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.
