WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED:

- Middle and Lower Main Pampanga River
- Pasac-Guagua Allied River Basins (Abacan, Porac-Gumain, and other streams and creeks within the Sub-Basin)
- Ponding of rainwater at relatively low-lying areas

AWARENESS INFORMATION/WARNING:

- Generally, rivers within the Sub-Basin are still relatively low. However, the Southwest Moonson rains (Habagat) is expected to continue over the western sections of the Pampanga River Basin (PRB).
- Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils adjacent to and/or along the above-mentioned waterways are advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and river overflowing at midstream and downstream areas.
