BASIN EXPECTED HYDROLOGICAL RESPONSE:

 A new ris of water level of the middle main Cagayan River and Magat River due to light to moderate rains and release of Magat Dam.

FLOODING IS THREATENING WITHIN THE NEXT 12 HOURS: in the low lying areas of Naguilian, Gamu, Ilagan, Tumauini, Delfin Albano, Sto Tomas, Cabagan, Sta Maria and San Pablo.

Gradual rise of lower main Cagayan River and its tributaries Pinacanauan River of Tuguegarao, Pared River, Dummun River, and Chico River and to reach its above alarm level of 9 meters.

FLOODING IS THREATENING WITHIN THE NEXT 12 HOURS: in the low lying areas of Tuguegarao City, Enrile, Solana, Iguig, Amulung, Alcala, Gattaran, Lallo, Lasam, Baggao, Camalanuigan, and Aparri

THE RESIDENTS IN THE LOW LYING AREAS AND THE DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCILS CONCERNED ARE ADVISED TO TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTIONS.

ACTION/S TAKEN:

NDRRMC Flood Bulletin No. **03** for Cagayan river basin system was disseminated to OCD/RDRRMC- II through facsimile, SMS and website for further dissemination to the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.

Directed RDRRMC II through the OCD Regional Center to undertake precautionary measures in their area of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
