- Continues rise of middle main Cagayan river and its tributaries:
 Magat River, Pinacanauan Rivers of Ilagan, Tumauni and San Pablo.
 Flooding will persist within the next 12 hours
 In the low lying areas of Naguilian, Gamu, Ilagan, Tumauini, Delfin Albano, Sto Tomas, Cabangan, Sta. Maria and San Pablo.
- 3. Continues rise of lower main Cagayan river and its tributaries: Pinacanauan River of Tuguegarao, Chico, Pared and Dummun rivers Flooding will persist within the next 12 hours In the low lying areas of Tuguegarao City, Enrile, Tuao, Solana, Iguig, Amulung, Alcala, Gattaran, Lallo, Lasam, Baggao, Camalanuigan and Aparri

People living near mountain slopes and low lying areas particularly those adjacent to and/along the above mentioned rivers and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMC's) concerned are still advised to take necessary appropriate actions.
