**AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL (AS OF 8:00 AM, 27 AUGUST 2017):**

PAST 24-HRS OBSERVED RAINFALL: **6.7 mm**

FORECAST 24-HR RAINFALL : **LIGHT TO OCCASIONALLY MODERATE RAINS**

**WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED FURTHER:**

**TRIBUTARIES OF UPPER AND MIDDLE MAIN AGNO RIVER:**

**PUBLIC WARNING:**

Water levels of rivers within the Basin are generally receding until they reach below alarm level stage. However, minor flooding still remain in the low lying areas due to accumulated rainwaters, but will slowly subside in the next few days.
