PRESENT WEATHER:

ITCZ AFFECTING MINDANAO AND PALAWAN. PARTLY CLOUDY SKIES WITH ISOLATED RAINSHOWERS OR THUNDERSTORMS OVER BICOL REGION.

BASIN RAINFALL AS OF 11:00 PM, 22 October 2018:

PAST 12- HOUR RAINFALL: LIGHT RAINSHOWER

FORECAST 24-HR RAINFALL: ISOLATED LIGHT RAINS

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED:

Bicol river and streams particularly Sipocot Tributary River. Streams and River tributary of the low-lying areas of municipality of Libon, Polangui, Oas, Ligao, Bato, Nabua, Baa, Bula, Buhi, Iriga City, Pili, Camaligan, Bombon, Magarao, Canaman, Naga City, Gainza, Milaor, Minalabac, Pamplona, San Fernando, Calabanga, Cabusao, Libmanan, Sipocot and Lupi.

People living near the mountain slopes and low-lying areas near the above-mentioned rivers and streams are advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides, and the local disaster risk reduction and management councils concerned are advised to be alert and take appropriate actions.
