BASIN RAINFALL as of **7:00 AM** TODAY

OBSERVED PAST 24-HR RAINFALL: **30.2 MILLIMETERS**

FORECAST 24-HR RAINFALL: **20 to 40 MILLIMETERS**

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED:

- Tributary of Rio Choco River
- Lower Main Pampanga River
- CANDABA Swamp Area
- Pasac-Guagua Allied River Basin (Abacan, Pasig-Potrero, Porac-Gumain and Other Streams and Creeks within the Sub-Basin.
- (Ponding of rainwater at relatively low-lying areas)

PUBLIC WARNINGS:

All rivers within the basin are generally slowly increasing. However, are still way below their respective alert levels. Monsoon rains will continue to prevail over the basin. Residents and Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) adjacent to and/or along the abovementioned waterways and in the low-lying seashore areas affected by hightide are advised to be on alert for possible flash floods and/or river overflowing along the said waterways.
