**AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL (MM):
PAST 103-HRS. ENDING AT 3:00 PM TODAY = 212.3 MM**

**FORECAST FOR THE NEXT 24-HRS.
BEGINNING 3:00PM TODAY = LIGHT TO MODERATE RAINS**

BASIN EXPECTED RESPONSE:

- 1. Water levels of Allied-Sinocalan to remain at critical level.**
 - FLOODING IS EXPECTED TO PERSIST:** In the low-lying areas of Sta Barbara, Calasiao, Binmaley and Cities of Dagupan and Urdaneta.
- 2. Slow rise of Lower Agno River and tributaries.**
 - FLOODING IS STILL THREATENING:** In the low-lying areas of parts of Bayambang, San Carlos City, Urbiztondo, Mangatarem, Aguilar, Bugallon and Lingayen.
- 3. Slow recession of tributaries Tarlac and Camiling Rivers.**
 - FLOODING IS STILL THREATENING:** In the low-lying areas of parts of Gerona, Paniqui, Moncada, Sta. Ignacia, Mayantoc and Camiling.
