**AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL AS OF 04:00PM TODAY**  
**PAST 37-HR OBSERVED RAINFALL = 88 MM**  
**FORECAST FOR THE NEXT 12-HR = LIGHT RAINS**

#### EXPECTED HYDROLOGICAL RESPONSE:

1. **Slow Recession** of **middle** main Cagayan River and Its Tributaries:  
**Magat, Pinacanauan Rivers of Ilagan, Tumauini and San Pablo.**  
**Flooding will continue to persist within the next 12 hours**  
**In the low lying areas of Naguilan, Gamu, Ilagan, Tumaini, Delfin Albano, Sto Tomas, Cabagan, Sta Maria and San Pablo.**
2. **Slow rise** of lower main Cagayan river and its tributaries:  
Pinacanauan River of Tuguegarao, Chico, Pared and Dummun rivers  
**Flooding will continue persist within the next 12 hours**  
In the low lying areas of Tuguegarao City, Enrile, Tuao, Solana, Iguig, Amulung, Alcala, Gattaran, Lallo, Lasam, Baggao, Camalanuigan and Aparri

People living near mountain slopes and low lying areas particularly those adjacent to and/along the above mentioned rivers and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMC's) concerned are still advised to take necessary appropriate actions.
