AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL AS OF 4:00 PM TODAY

PAST 72-HRS OBSERVED RAINFALL: 98 MM

FORECAST FOR THE NEXT 24-HRS = LIGHT TO MODERATE RAINS

BASIN EXPECTED RESPONSE:

- 1. WATER LEVELS OF ALLIED-SINOCALAN AND TAGAMUSING RIVERS TO REACH ITS PEAK.**
 - **Flooding still persist:** In the low lying areas of Sta. Barbara, Calasiao, Binmaley, Binalonan and Cities of Dagupan and Urdaneta.
- 2. SLOW RECESSION OF ALLIED-BUED, PATALAN, ANGALACAN, AND ALORAGAT RIVERS.**
 - **Flooding is no longer possible:** In the low lying areas of Mangaldan, Mapandan, San Fabian, San Jacinto, Laoac, Manaoag, Sison and Pozorrubio.
- 3. SLOW RECESSION OF UPPER AND MIDDLE MAIN AGNO RIVER AND TRIBUTARIES. (CURRENT WATER RELEASE OF SAN ROQUE DAM as of 3:00 PM, today: 1 gate open; Total opening = 1 meter; TOTAL OUTFLOW = 444 cu.m/sec).**
 - **Flooding is possible:** In the low lying areas of some parts of San Nicolas, San Manuel (Pangasinan), Asingan, Tayug, Sta. Maria, Rosales, Villasis, Sto. Tomas and Alcala.
- 4. SLOW RISE OF LOWER MAIN AGNO RIVER (DUE TO CURRENT WATER RELEASE OF SAN ROQUE DAM as of 3:00 PM, today: 1 gate open; Total Opening = 1 meter; Total Outflow = 444 cu. m/sec)**

- **Flooding is threatening**: In the low lying areas of some parts of Bautista, Bayambang, San Carlos City, Urbiztondo, Mangatarem, Aguilar, Bugallon, Labrador and Lingayen.
