EXPECTED HYDROLOGICAL RESPONSE:

Recession of lower main Cagayan River and its tributaries: Pinacanauan River of Tuguegarao, Chico, Pared and Dummun Rivers. Water level to REMAIN ABOVE ALERT LEVEL due to light rains caused by the Northeast Monsoon. (Magat Dam release as of 4:00 AM; 1-gate-open; 1.0 metres TOTAL OPENING; Outflow to Magat River=447 cms).

FLOODING IS STILL POSSIBLE in the low-lying areas of Tuguegarao City, Enrile, Tuao, Solana, Iguig, Amulung, Alcala, Gattaran, Lallo, Lasam, Baggao, Camalaniugan and Aparri.

PUBLIC WARNING:

People living near low-lying areas particularly those adjacent to and along the above-mentioned rivers are alerted against possible landslides and flashfloods and the DRRMCS concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.
