Arayat Stn., Pampanga River	Now at 8.60 m., / had leveled-off and to remain above 8.50m. Critical WL and slow recession in progress	Flooding to occur at riverside areas	Arayat, San Luis, Sta. Ana, San Simon
Candaba Stn., Candaba Swamp	Now at 5.73 m., / Slow-filling up above 5.00 m. Critical WL to continue until tomorrow	Flooding to occur	Candaba Swamp Area
Sasmuan Stn., Guagua River	Now at 2.47 m. / To fluctuate (tide influenced) but to remain below 3.2 m. WL	Flooding is still possible	Sasmuan, Lubao, Guagua

Sulipan Stn., Pampanga River	Now at 2.84 m. Slow rise to continue to reach 3.60. Alert WL tomorrow	Flooding is still possible	Apalit, Macabebe, Masantol, Calumpit, Paombong, Hagonoy
Angat River	Still relatively low; slight increase in river stage	Flooding is still possible	Riverside areas of Angat, Norzagaray, Bustos, San Rafael, Baliuag, Pulilian, Plaridel, Calumpit
Coastal Flooding in the Low-Lying seashore areas (Tide Influenced)			Hagonoy, Paombong, Macabebe, Masantol
