AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL AS OF 4:00 AM TODAY

PAST **84-HRS** OBSERVED RAINFALL: **98 MM**
FORECAST FOR THE NEXT 24-HRS = **LIGHT RAINS**

BASIN EXPECTED RESPONSE:

- SLOW RECESSION OF ALLIED-SINOCALAN ENGALERA AND TAGAMUSING RIVERS.**
 - Flooding to RECEDE SLOWLY**: In the low lying areas of Sta. Barbara, Calasiao, and cities of Dagupan and Urdaneta.
- SLOW RECESSION OF UPPER AND MIDDLE MAIN AGNO RIVER AND TRIBUTARIES. (CURRENT WATER RELEASE OF SAN ROQUE DAM as of 3:00 AM, today: 1 gate open; Total opening = 1 meter; TOTAL OUTFLOW = 444 cu.m/sec).**
 - Flooding is still POSSIBLE**: In the low lying areas of some parts of San Nicolas, San Manuel (Pangasinan), Asingan, Tayug, Sta. Maria, Rosales, Villasis, Sto. Tomas and Alcala.
- SLOW RISE OF LOWER MAIN AGNO RIVER (DUE TO CURRENT WATER RELEASE OF SAN ROQUE DAM as of 3:00 AM, Today= 1 gate open; Total Opening = 1 meter; Total Outflow = 444 cu. m/sec)**
 - Flooding is THREATENING**: In the low lying areas of some parts of Bautista, Bayambang, San Carlos City, Urbiztondo, Mangatarem, Aguilar, Bugallon, Labrador and Lingayen.

The residents and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are advised to take necessary and appropriate actions.
