AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL:

PAST 120-HRS., ENDING AT 3:00 AM TODAY = 305 MM

FORECAST 24-HRS., BEGINNING 3:00 AM TODAY = LIGHT RAINS

BASIN EXPECTED RESPONSE:

1. Floodwaters from allied Sinocalan-Pantal and Macalong Rivers to subside slowly.
 - **FLOODING STILL REMAIN:** In the low lying areas of Sta. Barbara, Calasiao, Binmaley and Cities of Dagupan and Urdaneta.
2. Water levels of Upper and Middle Agno River to remain above alert level (due to the release of San Roque Dam, as of 3:00AM; 1-Gate-0.5M-Opening; TOTAL OUTFLOW=344 CMS).
 - **FLOODING IS STILL POSSIBLE:** In the low lying areas of San Manuel (Pangasinan), Asingan, Tayug, Sta. Maria, Rosales, Villasis and Sto. Tomas.
3. Water levels of Lower Agno River (due to the release of San Roque Dam, as of 3:00AM; 1-Gate-0.5M-Opening; TOTAL OUTFLOW=344 CMS) to remain above alarm level.
 - **FLOODING IS STILL THREATENING:** In the low-lying areas of Alcala, Bautista, Bayambang, San Carlos City, Urbiztondo, Mangatarem, Aguilar, Bugallon, Labrador and Lingayen.

THE RESIDENTS AND THE LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCILS (LDRRMCs) CONCERNED ARE STRONGLY ADVISED TO TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTIONS.

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- Disseminated Flood Bulletin No. 9 for Agno and Allied River Basins to OCD Regional Center I through SMS and facsimile and uploaded same at the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMC concerned through the OCD Regional Center to undertake precautionary measures in their Area of Responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
