 - Directed RDRRMC(s) concerned through the OCD Regional Center to undertake precautionary measures in their Area of Responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
