AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL (MM):
PAST 72-HRS. ENDING AT 3:00 AM TODAY = 161.9 MM

FORECAST FOR THE NEXT 24-HRS.
BEGINNING 3:00 AM TODAY = LESS THAN 15 MILLIMETERS

BASIN EXPECTED RESPONSE:

- 1. Water levels of allied-Pantal-Sinocalan and Marusay Rivers to remain within critical level.**
 - FLOODING TO PERSIST**: In the low-lying areas of Sta Barbara, Calasiao, Binmaley, Dagupan City and Urdaneta City.
- 2. Water level of lower Agno River to remain above alert lever.**
 - FLOODING IS STILL THREATENING**: In the low-lying areas of parts of Bayambang, San Carlos City, Urbiztondo, Mangatarem, Aguilar, Bugallon, Labrador and Lingayen.
- 3. Slow recession of tributaries Tarlac and Camiling Rivers.**
 - FLOODING STILL REMAIN**: In the low-lying areas of parts of San Manuel (Tarlac,), Tarlac City, Gerona, Paniqui, Moncada, STa. Ignacia, Mayantoc and Camiling.
