AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL AS OF 04:00 PM TODAY
PAST 24-HR OBSERVED RAINFALL = 25 MM
FORECAST FOR THE NEXT 12-HR = MODERATE TO HEAVY RAINS

EXPECTED HYDROLOGICAL RESPONSE:

1. Gradual rise up upper main Cagayan River and Its Tributaries:
Diadi, Ganano, Magat, Siffu and Mallig Rivers.
Flooding is expected to occur within the next 12 hours
In the low lying areas of Santiago, San Agustin, Jones, Echague, Angadanan, Alicia and Cauayan.
2. Gradual rise of middle main Cagayan river and its tributaries:
Pinacanauan Rivers of Ilagan, Tumauni and San Pablo
Flooding is expected to occur within the next 12 hours
In the low lying areas of Naguilian, Gamu, Ilagan, Tumauni, Delfin Albano, Sto Tomas, Cabagan, Sta. Maria and San Pablo.
3. Gradual Rise of lower main Cagayan River and Its Tributaries:
Pinacanauan River of Tuguegarao, Chico, Pared, Zinundungan, Abulug and Dummun Rivers.
Flooding will continue to persist within the next 12 hours
In the low lying areas of Tuguegarao City, Enrile, Tuao, Solana, Iguig, Amulung, Alcala, Tuao, Rizal, Gattaran, Lallo, Lasam, Baggao, Camalanuigan, Aparri, Buguey, Sta. Ana, Gonzaga, and Sta. Teresita.

People living near mountain slopes and low lying areas particularly those adjacent to and/along the above mentioned rivers and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMC's) concerned are still advised to take necessary appropriate actions.
