AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL (MM):

PAST 24-HRS. ENDING AT 3:00 PM TODAY - LIGHT RAINS

FORECAST FOR THE NEXT 24-HRS.

**BEGINNING 3:00 PM TODAY - LIGHT TO OCCASIONAL
MODERATE RAINS**

BASIN EXPECTED RESPONSE:

1. **Water levels of allied-Pantal-Sinocalan and Marusay Rivers to recede slowly until it reaches below alert level.**
 - **FLOODING IS NO LONGER EXPECTED TO PERSIST WITHIN THE NEXT 24-HOURS:** In the low-lying areas of Sta Barbara, Calasiao, Binmaley, Dagupan City and Urdaneta City.
2. **Water level of lower Agno River to recede slowly until it reaches below alert level.**
 - **FLOODING IS NO LONGER EXPECTED TO PERSIST:** In the low-lying areas of parts of Bayambang, San Carlos City, Urbiztondo, Mangatarem, Aguilar, Bugallon, Labrador and Lingayen.
3. **Slow recession of tributaries Tarlac and Camiling Rivers.**
 - **FLOODING is no longer expected to persist:** In the low-lying areas of parts of San Manuel (Tarlac), Tarlac City, Gerona, Paniqui, Moncada, Sta. Ignacia, Mayantoc and Camiling.

With this development, unless significant rains will prevail over the basin the near future, this is the final bulletin.
