AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL AS OF 04:00 PM TODAY
PAST 24-HR OBSERVED RAINFALL = LIGHT RAINS
FORECAST FOR THE NEXT 12-HR = LIGHT RAINS

EXPECTED HYDROLOGICAL RESPONSE:

1. **Continuous recession** of lower main Cagayan River and Its Tributaries: Pinacanauan River of Tuguegarao, Chico, Pared, Zinundungan, Abulug and Dummun.

Flooding will no longer persist within the next 12 hours

In the low lying areas of Tuguegarao City, Enrile, Tuao, Solana, Iguig, Amulung, Alcalan, Rizal, Gattaran, Lallo, Lasam, Baggao, Camalanuigan, and Aparri.

With this development unless significant rains will occur in the immediate future, this is the final bulletin.

People living near mountain slopes and low lying areas particularly those adjacent to and/along the above mentioned rivers and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are still advised to take necessary appropriate actions.
