# **EXPECTED HYDROLOGICAL RESPONSE:**

1. Slow rise of middle main Cagayan River and its tributaries: Pinacanauan Rivers of Ilagan, Tumauini, and San Pablo.

<u>FLOODING IS POSSIBLE</u> in the low-lying areas of Naguilian, Gamu, Ilagan, Tumauini, Delfin Albano, Sto. Tomas, Cabagan, Sta. Maria, and San Pablo.

2. Slow rise of lower main Cagayan River and its tributaries: Pinacanauan River of Tuguegarao, Chico, Pared, and Dummun Rivers.

<u>FLOODING IS POSSIBLE</u> in the low-lying areas of Tuguegarao City, Enrile, Tuao, Solana, Iguig, Amulung, Alcala, Gattaran, Lallo, Lasam, Baggao, Camalanuigan, and Aparri.

### **PUBLIC WARNING:**

People living near low-lying areas particularly those adjacent to and along the above-mentioned rivers are alerted against possible landslides and flashfloods and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.
