AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL (MM):
PAST 12-HRS. ENDING AT 5:00 PM TODAY = 32 MM
FORECAST FOR THE NEXT 12-HRS. = LIGHT RAINS

EXPECTED HYDROLOGICAL RESPONSE:

- 1. Recession of Middle Main Cagayan River and its Tributaries Magat, Siffu, Mallig Rivers, Pinagcanauan Rivers of Ilagan Tumauni and San Pablo (located at Isabela Province).**
 - **FLOODING IS NO LONGER POSSIBLE:** In the low-lying areas of Naguilian, Gamu, Ilagan, Tumauni, Delfin Albano, Sto Tomas Cabagan, Sta Maria and San Pablo. This is Final for the said areas.
- 2. Slow rise of Lower main Cagayan River and its Tributaries Pinagcauanan River of Tuguegarao, Pared River, Dummun River, Chico River, Zinundungan River**
 - **FLOODING IS STILL POSSIBLE:** In the low-lying areas of Tuguegarao City, Enrile, Solana, Iguig, Amulung, Alcala, Gattaran, Lallo, Lasam, Baggao, Camalanuigan and Aparri.

The residents in the low lying areas and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are still advised to take appropriate actions.
