- Tributaries Coronel, Digmala, Talavera, And Penaranda Rivers in Nueva Ecija
- Tributaries San Miguel, Bulu, Madlum, Garlang, and Maasim Rivers in Bulacan

PUBLIC WARNING:

Generally, the Basin remains relatively dry; however, residents and Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) adjacent to and / or along the abovementioned waterways particularly those at the upstream potions including those who are near mountain slopes are advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides starting late this afternoon.
