TOTAL BASIN RAINFALL:

PAST **24-HRS.**, ENDING AT **3:00 PM** TODAY = **4.2 MM**
FORECAST **12-HRS.** = LIGHT RAINS

BASIN EXPECTED HYDROLOGICAL RESPONSE:

1. Continues Recession of Lower Main Cagayan Rivers and its tributaries Pinacauan River of Tuguegarao, Pared River, dummum River, Zinundungan River and Chico River. This is an Final for the said Areas.
2. Flooding in no longer expected to persist within the next 24 hrs in the low lying areas of Tuguegarao City, Enrile, Solana, Iguig, Amulung, Alcala, Gattaran, Lallo, Lasam, Baggao, Camalanuigan and Apparri.

WITH THIS DEVELOPMENT, UNLESS SIGNIFICANT RAINS WILL BE OCCUR IN THE IMMEDIATE FUTURE TO AFFECT THE BASIN, , THIS IS THE FINAL BULLETIN.

ACTIONS TAKEN:

NDRRMC-OPCEN

- Disseminated Flood Bulletin No. **07 (FINAL)** for Cagayan river basins to OCD Regional Center II through SMS and facsimile and uploaded same at the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMC II through the OCD Regional Center to undertake precautionary measures in their Area of Responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low – lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
