#### PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm "JOLINA" was estimated based on all available data at 310 km East Southeast of Casiguran, Aurora (15.3°N, 124.8°E) with maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 80 km/h. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 19 km/h.
