**AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "JOSIE" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 470 KM NORTH NORTHEAST OF BASCO, BATANES (24.5 °N, 123.2 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF UP TO 55 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 65 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTHWEST AT 20 KM/H. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON AND VISAYAS. TROPICAL STORM AMPIL (FORMERLY "INDAY") @ 03:00 AM LOCATION: 1,495 KM NORTH OF EXTREME NORTHERN LUZON (33.7 °N, 119.6 °E) [OUTSIDE PAR] MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS: 75 KM/H GUSTINESS: UP TO 120 KM/H MOVEMENT: NORTHWEST AT 25 KM/H.**
