THE NORTHERN AND EASTERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON AND CENTRAL LUZON (Batanes, Calayan, Babuyan, Cagayan, Isabela, Northern Coast of Ilocos Norte and Aurora)	Cloudy skies with light rains	(45 - 63) / (24 - 34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5
THE WESTERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON (Ilocos Sur, La Union, Pangasinan, And Western Coast of Ilocos Norte)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains	(45 - 63) / (24 - 34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
