AGUSAN DEL NORTE - particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran. SURIGAO DEL SUR - particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.
