



Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal • CAVITE particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-Ilang and Imus • QUEZON particularly Upper Umiray, Lower Bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking-Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Yabahaan, Bigol, Guinhalinan, Vinas, Calauag, Pandanan, Sta. Lucia, Lugan, Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island), and Upper Kilbay – Catabangan • BATANGAS particularly Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kapumpong, Rosario-Lobo and Upper Bolbok (Lawaya) • RIZAL particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa

No. 05 for Region VIII (EASTERN VISAYAS)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LEYTE particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan, and Binahaan • EASTERN SAMAR particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga, and Sulat • NORTHERN SAMAR particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano, and Gamay • SOUTHERN LEYTE particularly Bisay, Himbangan, and Pandan • SAMAR particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga, and Jibatan

No. 02 for for Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to occasionally moderate rains and thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• BENGUET particularly Upper Bauang• APAYAO particularly Upper Abulug• ABRA particularly Upper Abra, Tineg and Ikmin
