WATERWAYS LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED:

- Upper Main Cagayan River
- Middle Main Cagayan River
- Tributary Rivers (Pinagcanauan of Ilagan, San Pablo and Tuguegarao, Ganano, Magat, Chico, Pared, and Dummun River)

PUBLIC WARNING:

- Generally, rivers within the Basin are still relatively low. However, northeasterly windflow (Northern Monsoon) will bring light to moderate rains over the Basin. People living near mountain slopes and adjacent to or along the above mentioned waterways and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) are advised to be prepared and to be alert for possible flashfloods at mainstream and downstream areas
